Erin a language student from University of Ulster, Coleraine Northern Ireland is on a 2 week trip to Hangzhou to learn about Chinese life and culture. Yesterday afternoon we met at the Zhejiang Media University for a chat to discuss her experience so far.

Q. Hello we are both students here at Zhejiang Media University, if you wouldn't mind we would like to ask you a few questions about your first impressions of China?

The main thing I have noticed is the food here is very different, especially at meal times and the variety of dishes.

Normally in the UK for breakfast we wouldn't have rice or noodles we would have cereal or toast instead. Also using chopsticks was difficult to master at the beginning, in UK we use knives & forks and spoons. In addition the dishes are very unusual in particular chicken feet and turtle soup were quite shocking.

Q. Is university life here similar to that in the UK?

No student life here, is very different to the UK as here there are very strict rules and curfews. In my university we don't have bells also the university in China is huge and probably about 10 times the size of our university in the UK. Many the students in the UK only live on campus for their first year and then in private housing near the university but here the students live on campus for their entire degree course.

Q. What has your experience been of daily life here in China?

It is very hot and humid here whereas in the UK it rains most of the time and we only have a few hot sunny days during the summer. I was surprised at how cheap everything is to buy out here especially clothes and food. It's quite unusual to see people using umbrellas to protect them from the sun rather than the rain like in the UK.

Also one of the more difficult things to adapt to were the different type of toilets here compared to the UK.

Chinese cities are very overcrowded and huge compared to those in the UK.

Finally what myself and the other students from my university that are also on this trip find quite amusing is the fact that wherever we go people take photos and stare at us.

Q. Finally what have been your highlights so far during your stay?

I really enjoyed visiting Shanghai and seeing the amazing skyscrapers and view from the top floor of the Oriental Pearl, also the beautiful gardens in Suzhou. I have found many Chinese people to be very welcoming and even though there are many differences between life in China and the UK I would like to return to another part of China in the future as it is a country which has a fascinating culture and history.


If you want me use a few words to describe my favorite director Woody Allen, it must be geeks, neurotic, old elf, prudish What he impressed me most was the one he refused to lead the world's lifetime Achievement Award, 13 nominations but did not participate.

Second, he was a 78-year-old could have been directed and starred in the all-around filmmaker, basically every year a new movie release. Third, Woody Allen's private life is rich. Fourth, the film's pseudo-documentary style. But today I want from “chameleon” to talk about a pseudo-documentary in the works of Woody Allen movies.

“Chameleon” shot in 1983 in the form of black and white documentary fiction in 1928, tells the story of a biography about Zelig, he has an amazing ability, can always be like “Chameleon”, as some people become close. By the Alan himself starred Zelig, and then-girlfriend Mia Farrow starred in the spirit of the physician to cure Zelig Eudora Eudora.



Mockumentary biggest feature is: a combination of real and fictional, using plausible picture, Paralanguage and viewers unfamiliar actors, or even trying to use a lot of simulation tools largest real three-dimensional to the audience, but actually is fictional. In the "chameleon" ,director woody allen used the old news, old photos, old recordings, made the old new photos, old new recordings , as well as to the negative scratches made to highlight the effect of twinkling old movies, etc. are intended to reflect reality. In addition, most of the story through photos and voice-over commentary to tell the story, in order to broaden the narrative, also interviewed Susan Sontag, Irving Howe, Saul Bellow and other modern intellectuals are making the audience believe that the film's three-dimensional sense and realism. In short, do the old videos, photos, coupled with a strong three-dimensional recording interviews, just hard to find, this story is completely fictional.





“Mockumentary”, also known as “fake documentary.” It uses satire or parody way to analyze large social events or issues, challenges people to the established fact of cognition, and the true concept of the documentary in the core proposition. In the “chameleon”, the true story through a series of seemingly triggered the audience to reflect on humanity. For example: The doctor responsible for medical Zelig unheard of that person’s condition, is calculated using the sensibility of his way to conduct a thorough study to identify themselves to the audience to think about this behavior. Besides, directed by clever use of irony way to analyze large social events or issues, challenges people’s awareness for the established fact, and for documentaries in the core proposition true concept. In the series "[My Love from The Star](#)," the main character tends to say: "It's time for some fried chicken and beer in a warm air-conditioned room." All of a sudden, on the tables of many dorms and in Weibo and Weixin (or WeChat) updates, the combo went viral.

Soon, it became a fad among young people who like to order fried chicken from restaurants such as KFC and McDonald's and eat them with beer. Smelling an opportunity there, some restaurants added fried chicken in the menu. It's reported

that a cinema is considering replacing the traditional combo of popcorn and coke with a fried-chicken-and-kvass combo. Kvass is a light beer considered suitable for watching movie. Sim June-bo, owner of Barsak Chicken and Beer, a Korean restaurant in Beijing's Wangjing district, said he has noticed a significant increase in the restaurant's Chinese clientele since the show began airing.

"I have been doing fried chicken business for eight years, but this is the first time I've seen so many Chinese clients coming to order fried chicken with beer," he said.

"In the past, 40% of our clients who ordered fried chicken were Chinese and 60% were Korean. Now it is 80% Chinese and 20% Korean," Mr. Sim said, adding that one day last week there were as many as 100 people waiting to get some fried chicken to go.

At another fried chicken takeaway joint in Wangjing, which is home to several Korean eateries, an employee surnamed Zhang said the restaurant also has seen a notable increase in business.

"Our daily revenue used to be about several hundred yuan, but since last month, it has grown rapidly and can reach as much as 3,000 yuan per day," he said.

Even those who don't follow the drama are falling for the chicken-and-beer craze. Mr. Li works for a media company said he went to a Korean chimek restaurant last weekend with some friends who are fans of the drama and waited in line for about two hours to buy some fried chicken to go.

"After I posted pictures from the restaurant, I got calls from my friends to ask me how to get there," he said.



Should a woman fall in love with a man because he desires her so much? Men seem to think so. It's not about the woman, it's about the man's desire. We all know there is no such thing as a vampire. Come on now, what is "Twilight" really about? It's about a teenage boy trying to practice abstinence, and how, in the heat of the moment, it's really, really hard. And about a girl who wants to go all the way with him, and doesn't care what might happen. He's so beautiful she would do anything for him. She is the embodiment of the sentiment, "I'd die for you." She is, like many adolescents, a thanatophile.

If there were no vampires in "Twilight," it would be a thin-blooded teenage romance, about two good-looking kids who want each other so much because they want each other so much. Sometimes that's all it's about, isn't it? They're in love with being in love. In "Twilight," however, they have a seductive disagreement about whether he should kill her. She's like, I don't especially want to die, but if that's what it takes, count me in. She is touched by his devotion. Think what a sacrifice he is making on her behalf. On Prom Night, on the stage of the not especially private gazebo in the public gardens, he teeters right on the brink of a fang job, and then brings all of her trembling to a dead stand-still.

The movie is lush and beautiful, and the actors are well-chosen. Kristen Stewart's Bella, on the other hand, is a fresh-faced innocent who is totally undefended against his voltage.

Bella has left her mom and stepdad in hot Arizona, clutching a potted cactus, to come live in the clammy, rainy Pacific Northwest, home of Seasonal Affective Disorder. Her dad (Billy Burke) is the chief of police of the very small town of Forks, Washington (pop. 3,120). His greatest asset: "He doesn't hover." At high school, she quickly notices the preternaturally pale Cullen clan, who in some shots seem to be wearing as much Max Factor Pancake White as Harry Langdon. Edward is 114 years old. He must be really tired of taking biology class. Darwin came in during his watch, and proved vampires can't exist.

There are other strange youths around, including American Indians who appear not too distantly descended from their tribe's ancestors, wolves. Great tension between the wolves and vampires. Also some rival vampires around. How small is this town? The Forks high school is so big, it must serve a consolidated district serving the whole table setting. The main local Normal Kid is a nice sandy-haired boy who asks Bella to the prom. He's out of his depth here, unless he can transmogrify into a grizzly. Also there are four grey-bearded coots at the next table in the local diner, who eavesdrop and exchange significant glances and get big, significant close-ups but are still just sitting significantly nodding, for all I know.
